If we look at the front of the card and the box marked "camp" on the top left there are two Japanese Characters crossed through. These indicate the Singapore POW Administration at Changi, and the fact they are crossed through means he was transferred.

Above those characters we see a single one for the Thailand POW Administration, so he was transferred onto Burma Siam Railway. Keeping to the very top, move to the right, and we see the Thailand character again

with the Roman numeral IV, and the numbers 11317. The numeral IV indicates he was part of Work Group 4, and his POW number was 11317.
